

Rest assured that Granger will make the nuts and bolts of Builders Risk way more interesting than we have any right to expect.

PSAA... you never know what you're going to get. I guess you'll just have to show up to find out.

Speaking of never knowing what you're going to get, John Walker and his team of bowlers should have won the PSAA Bowling Tournament based entirely on their luck of the lane. Their ball return mechanism malfunctioned, which shorted out the pin-setter device, and that caused the scoring software to go rogue. The alley went dark, and no pins were set up, but so long as John and his teammates rolled a ball down the alley it scored a strike. The ball could roll down the entire way in the gutter and they would be credited with a strike.

Team Walker were bowling with their eyes shut, rolling the ball backwards between their legs, seeing how fast they could roll the ball, and seeing how slow they could roll the ball Bowlers in other lanes were wary of the inaccuracy of the high velocity bowling balls, and they had to chase down a couple of those slow rolling balls that were never going to make it all the way to the pins. John's teammates even got altitude on some of their shots, and one of them had to be talked out of attempting to bowl overhand.
