For those who paid and registered for the Sept. Luncheon, your payment/registration will be transferred to the Nov. 17th meeting.



That means that the September PSAA and OCAA meetings are essentially the first day of school wherein you reconnect with those cohorts you haven't seen since the previous school year and reach out to all the new faces who are showing up to PSAA and/or OCAA for the first time... or they're a "new face" who, for whatever reason, never showed up on your radar... or you are the new face checking out PSAA and/or OCAA for the first time.

If this is your first visit to a PSAA and/or OCAA meeting you need to remain vigilant and attentive during the entirety of the meeting because throughout our PSAA and OCAA history (we've been around since 1938) many a first timer has even been roped in to serving on the PSAA and/or OCAA Board of Directors, and we've coerced... I mean enticed... several newbies to immediately serve as PSAA and/or OCAA president.

Lizzy, Nancy, and Courtney remind me that PSAA and OCAA are like Fight Club. We don't talk about what goes on behind the scenes at Fight Club... I mean PSAA and OCAA (my apologies to those of you who never saw the Fight Club movie because this reference will probably make no sense to you).

Meanwhile, back at PSAA and OCAA, let's revisit why you (and every one of your fellow insurance claims professionals) should revisit the monthly PSAA and OCAA meetings. Off the top of my head, I can rattle off at least a dozen adjusters, vendors, attorneys, agents, and experts who make a point of traveling to both Seattle and Portland for the monthly PSAA and OCAA meetings. They may not make it to every meeting, but they are the regular attendees and familiar faces we can count on to fly the colors.

The insurance claims profession is continually evolving because the business of insurance is directly impacted by climate, weather (climate and weather are not the same thing, but most of you already know that), the economy, politics, global events, culture, governments, regulatory constraints, and human behavior. In other words, a butterfly flaps its wings in China creating a hurricane in the Caribbean; thus, in the insurance world change is constant and unpredictable.

A major domestic insurer admits that more than half of their claims staff have less than a year's experience. Another major insurer just laid off 2,400 claims representatives. Insurance companies continue to bail on and/or boycott Florida and California because the loss ratios are unsustainable. Catastrophe adjusters are burning out running nonstop from storm to storm. Several insurance companies are petitioning to limit water damage coverage to \$10,000, \$15,000, or \$25,000. Auto repair costs have quadrupled since before the pandemic, but insurance regulators refuse insurance companies requests to

raise premiums commensurate with their exposure. Policyholders are uploading photos, videos, and other documentation to enable insurers to adjust claims from remote locations. It is estimated that 80% of all claims representatives work from home. It is also predicted that in the very near future artificial intelligence (AI) will account for most claims and legal analysis.

I paint a dismal picture of my chosen profession, except that in my 46+ years as an insurance claims professional every year there are forecasts of doom and gloom surrounding insurance and claims. I was recruited while in college by a former Jesuit priest who held a JD in law and a PhD in Theology who told me that during his decades as an insurance claims adjuster every day was unlike any other filled with interesting people, situations other people only read about in the newspapers or saw on the evening news, learning new skills and science, helping needy claimants, and exposing liars, cheats, and criminals. He loved his work, but he recognized the challenges and frustrations that interfere with that love.


